## • Host a Diaper Drive

- o Who: The entire community!
- What: Collect dollars and diapers to donate to ADB more info and plenty of helpful resources at the link above.
- When: Drives can last anywhere from a week to a month or longer, at the organizers' discretion.
- Where: At the church (<u>if you submit it as a calendar event on our website</u>), or another location of your choosing (a library, a school, a local business, etc.), with their cooperation.
- o **Requirements:** ADB provides all the supplies needed to host a drive.
- Recommended Group Size: All who contribute are participants, we may have as many people participating in hosting a Diaper Drive as we like.

## Volunteer at the Bank

- o Who: Anyone 13 or older.
- What: Help ADB sort, count, and package diapers before they go out to help families all across Central Texas.
- When: Tuesday-Friday, either 10am-12pm, or 1pm-3pm. They're currently booked through 2022, but you can schedule a shift for your group of 6-10 volunteers in 2023 by emailing <u>Heather Trent</u>.

- Where: Austin Diaper Bank warehouse, 2210 Denton Dr, Suite 103, Austin, TX 78758
- Requirements: Volunteers need to be able to stand on their feet for 2 hours, and minors need to be accompanied by an adult.
- Recommended Group Size: 6-10 people (though you can check their website for volunteer opportunities for smaller groups, listed each month)
